

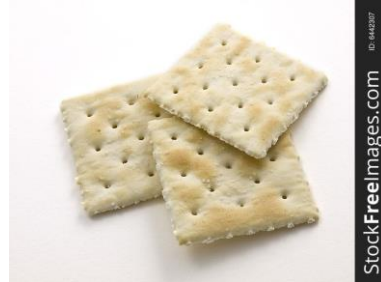

1. Put these Arabic numbers in order from 1-8.

خمسة
ستة
سبعة
ثمانية

2. In Arabic, how many total crackers?



3. These two tasks were the final experiments before Alex died. If you could have one final experiment with Alex, what would you do?

Answer 1: Alex could identify and correctly order Arabic numerals from one to eight, and Pepperberg said he spontaneously learned to equate these symbols with the appropriate number of objects.

واحد = 1

اثنان = 2

ثلاثة = 3

أربعة = 4

خمسة = 5

ستة = 6

سبعة = 7

ثمانية = 8

Answer 1: خمسة = 5. Alex could sum two sets of objects (such as crackers or jelly beans) as long as their sum total was six or less.
